HP is commonly known for its brand of computers, printers, and ink cartridges. However, many people are unaware of the essential role HP companies play in the illegal occupation of Palestine and violations of Palestinian human rights.

- HPE* provides servers to the State of Israel for its population registry. IDs that are issued based on this registry determine what level of rights Israeli citizens have. Under this system, Jewish citizens have more rights than non-Jewish citizens, and non-Jewish citizens have more rights than Palestinian citizens.
- HP Inc. is the exclusive provider of computers to the Israeli military, which carries out the occupation of Palestine, including the West Bank and East Jerusalem, as well as maintaining the brutal siege of the Gaza Strip.
- HPE provides servers and technology used in Israeli prisons. In Israeli prisons, Palestinians from all walks of life, including children, are frequently tortured and detained without charge. Israel's prison system is used to suppress Palestinian political activity, and to stifle opposition to its policies. By helping Israel run its prisons, HP is at the heart of Israel's use of mass incarceration to undermine Palestinian opposition to apartheid.
